Waives Need For Domicile Certificate Chaitanya.Marpakwar @timesgroup.com

Mumbai: In a move that is expected to have an impact ahead of next year's BMC polls, the Maharashtra gov-ernment has scrapped the condition for hawkers to have a Maharashtra dom-icile certificate. This means that to obtain a hawking li-cence, applicants no longer have to submit domicile cer-tificates to prove residence in the state for the last 15 years.

Domicile certificate is a document that certifies a document that certifies used to avail various servic-es provided by the govern-ment like admissions and government jobs. The per-dof stay in Maharashtra is 15 years. "...If any hawker has a domic.ile certificate, then it should be taken, but if they don't...then their survey must be conducted. As per the Centre's Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, when carry-ing out a survey of hawkers, their registration, and while giving them a hawking li-cence, Maharashtra State domicile should not be in-sisted upon," it added. years. On December 6, while working on their field, Vithal and Parashu-ram got into a heated argument. Vitthal picked up the rod lying nearby and hi his fa-ther many times, killing him on the spot be-fore dumping the remains in the borewell. 
